The City of Santa Rosa Public Works Department invites you to attend the second of two community meetings to discuss a proposed bicycle/pedestrian east-west connector over Highway 101 in the Santa Rosa Junior College area.

One purpose of this second meeting is to review the public input on the community's goals, issues, and priorities received during the community meeting held in February 2009. During this second meeting we will also assess the specific bridge alignments and structural design options developed as a result of the goals and priorities identified during the first meeting. Steven Grover and Associates, the architectural and engineering team performing the feasibility study, will make a presentation on the pros and cons of several design options. Visuals with preliminary images of the design options will be shown and discussed. The audience will be invited to participate in a written exercise in order to receive further input on the public's bridge preferences.

A Final Report will be developed summarizing the feasibility study process and the consensus reached through the two community meetings. This report will be presented to the City Council for their consideration and action.
