Visitor FAQs

Q: When is the fair open?

A: Saturday, Sunday, 10am-4pm

Q: What is the cost to enter – for both days

A: \$5 admission for adults; free for kids 12 and under. Keep your ticket for free re-entry.

Q: Can I visit my friend/family member with out paying the entry fee?

A: An entry fee is required unless you are working for a vendor and can present a Vendor Pass.

Q: Are facial masks required?

A: No, masks are recommended but not required while attending this year, regardless of vaccination status.

Q: What is the entertainment schedule?

A: There will be Live entertainment this year.

Q: Who is providing the food this year?

A: There will a food vendor onsite this year.

Q: What is 'Rosie the Trolley'?

A: Rosie is a free trolley that goes between the Craft Fair at Finley to the Holiday Open House at Luther Burbank Home & Gardens. See the "Rosie Stops Here" schedule in located in the circular driveway.

Q: Is there a lost & found?

A: Yes, inquire at the front desk.

Q: What if I can't find my child or a member of my party?

A: Ask the Front Desk or any staff member to assist you.

Q: Where are the restrooms?

A: Large maps are posted in the facility indicating women's and men's facilities in the Cedar and Sequoia lobbies. Additional restrooms are available in the Person Senior Wing across the courtyard.

Q: Where are the water drinking fountains?

A: There are drinking fountains located in the Sequoia and Cedar Lobbies, in the west wing hallway and in the Person Senior Wing lobby.

Q: I am looking for my friend's booth- do you have a map?

A: There are large maps listing all vendors posted in the front lobbies.

Q: Are dogs allowed at the Crafts Fair?

A: Service animals are allowed. Pets are not allowed.
