Agency	Amount Funded	Description
Humanidad Therapy & Education Services	\$2,930.95	One Circle Training which facilitate the following groups for male and female youths: "Living a Legacy: a Boys Council Rite of Passage," "Journey of the Great Warrior" and Body, Mind Spirit."
Martial Arts Youth Institute (MAYi)	\$1,300	MAYi works with "at risk" families teaching them a variety of life skills and how to use them at home, school, community and personal relationships. Funding requested covered several events MAYi holds throughout the year including Teen Nights Out, Halloween Lock In, Holiday parties, annual picnic and more.
Humanidad Therapy & Education Services	\$1,250	Humanidad is a muticulturally based Marriage, Family Therapist training program that provides counseling and education services to underserved populations. The funding requested was for one-time general operational costs.
Radrods of Norcal via Martial Arts for Youth Institute	\$1,600	Radrods provides a vocational training program teaching youth auto repair and restoration. The funding requested will cover costs for shirts, safety shoes, gloves, earplugs and safety glasses.
California Youth Outreach (CYO)	\$5,000	CYO Summer Sporting Camp provides sports, activities and community service for high-risk and gang-impacted youth.
Community Action Partnership	\$2,234	DIG Youth Leaders will be documenting the 2015 South Park Day and Night Festival (as a part of annual Gang Prevention Awareness Week) via a Youth Photo Voice Project. Funding requested is to cover operating costs and supplies for this one-time project/promotion.
Hillard Comstock Middle School	\$1,000	Funding requested is to cover supplies to continue the educational garden program at Comstock Middle School after Santa Rosa Charter School, who previously funded the garden, is moving to a different campus.
Social Advocates for Youth	\$3,750	Funding requested will cover costs for Sunflower Community Garden staff, educational field trips, leadership trainings and transportation to continue supporting the garden.
Family Justice Center Sonoma County	\$2,900	Funding requested will cover speaker fees, catering and printed materials at the Joint Conference: <u>Family Justice Center, Family Violence Prevention Council and the Santa Rosa Violence Prevention Partnership.</u>
