



West 9th Street Ruth Place Neighborhood – Special Notification IRONMAN Santa Rosa Event on Saturday May 11, 2019

On Saturday, May 11, 2019, the City of Santa Rosa and Santa Rosa Metro Chamber are co-hosting the annual IRONMAN Santa Rosa triathlon with the finish line in downtown Santa Rosa near Courthouse Square. The IRONMAN Santa Rosa will bring approximately 2,400 athletes and their support teams to Sonoma County where they will swim in Lake Sonoma, bike to downtown Santa Rosa, run the Santa Rosa Creek trail system, then finish in downtown Santa Rosa while covering 140.6 miles.

The purpose of this letter is to provide specific information to residents of your neighborhood so that Saturday plans may be adjusted to accommodate the race event and to minimize impacts to residents.

In your neighborhood...

- Road closures and detours will be in place from 11:30 AM to approximately 6 PM.
- Santa Rosa Police will be managing traffic and athletes at the intersection of Fulton Road & Chatham Drive
- **NO ACCESS to WESTBOUND W. 9th Street will be allowed.**
- **TO EXIT YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD**, you will be able to exit onto W. 9th Street and head **EAST ONLY** to W. 8th Street then either back to W. 9th Street via Simpson Street or take W. 8th Street to Dutton Ave.
- **TO ENTER YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD**, you can **ONLY** use Stony Point Road from the south, then head east on W. 9th Street.
- **USE HWY 101 to head NORTH of W. 9th Street.**
