Emergency Preparedness Kits should be considered for your **home, car, and office** to provide **food, water, and medical supplies** for a minimum of 3-5 days of being isolated following an earthquake or other major community disaster. You may be without water, electricity, phones and utilities for a week or more. Families and neighborhoods need to be ready to survive on their own.
