



WaterSmart Check-up Program For Multi-Family Residential Customers

Free Fixtures:	Showerheads:	Chrome or Polished Brass, 1.5 gallons per minute
	Kitchen Faucet Aerators:	Chrome, Spray and Stream, 1.5 gallons per minute
	Bathroom Faucet Aerators:	Chrome or Polished Brass, 1.0 gallons per minute
	Hose Nozzles:	Multi Position Sprays, Auto Shut-off

Applicant must:

- Have a City of Santa Rosa water account (service) in their name for the property where the project will be completed.
 - If the property owner is the participant in the program and not the water account holder, they must receive written consent from the water account holder using a City of Santa Rosa Tenant/Account Holder Permission Form.

Steps to Participate:

- 1) Call Water-Use Efficiency staff at 707-543-3985 to schedule a site visit
- 2) Prepare for site visit
 - a) Provide tenants at least 24-hour written notice prior to our entry
 - b) Have access for all units and common areas secured for our visit
 - c) Schedule to have a site representative, preferably a maintenance representative, present during the entire audit time
 - i) If possible, have site representative install the new efficient fixtures during the review
- 3) **Assessment Checklist Possibilities:**
 - a) Review water meter for movement
 - b) Check all fixtures for potential leaks
 - c) Check clothes washer(s) for general efficiency
 - d) Check dish washer(s) for general efficiency
 - e) Check kitchen faucet(s) for flow rate(s)
 - f) Check toilet(s) for flush volume(s)
 - g) Check bathroom faucet(s) for flow rate(s)
 - h) Check showerhead(s) for flow rate(s)
 - i) Review eligibility for other programs or rebates
- 4) Once check-up is completed, staff will prepare a report of findings regarding current water use and make recommendations with regard to increasing water use efficiency, including information on rebates and incentives. If current fixtures are not low flow, free showerheads and faucet aerators will be provided.
